(After the program, the classroom is open until 12 : 30 for resting or having lunch.)
- <How to join> Choose any dates from the class schedule below, and call to the YMCA for reservation.
- <Class fee> Please pay by cash on the day of your participation.
 - ★Regular Day . . . 500 yen (tax included) / 1 day 
 - ★Sensory Play / Thanksgiving . . . 600 yen (tax included) / 1 day
 - ★Special Day (Chie’s English Class) . . . 1000 yen (tax included)/ 1 day 
 - *Additionally, registration fee(200yen) will be charged at the first class.
- <Reservation> Please make sure to reserve in advance!

 - *For Tuesday and Wednesday classes, please reserve by Friday of the previous week.
